# How to Access Your Lexi-Comp ONLINE Evaluation Account

STEP 1: Go To <http://library.jefferson.edu> and click on the Lexi-Comp Link

STEP 2: Enter a drug name (brand or generic) in the "Search for" box (top left corner of screen) and click on the SEARCH button

STEP 3: The "SEARCH RESULTS" window will display every Lexi-Comp database containing a monograph for the search term entered.

STEP 4: There are two ways to review the information. The preferred method is to click the downward pointing arrow in the "Jump to Field (Select Field Name)" window near the top of the page. The second method is to use the scroll bar at the right side of the screen.
