

Things to know about Ebooks at Jefferson

1. The Scott Memorial Library has purchased close to 700 ebooks over the past few years. Here is a short demo on how you can search for them:

3. If you get an error message trying to access a specific e-book, it means that the user licenses are in use and that you should wait a few minutes to access the book. *Be considerate of fellow Jeffersonians (Log-off ebooks when finished)*
4. Check out all new ebook purchases from JEFFLINE homepage.

6. You cannot print out entire ebooks in one sitting. For example, with NetLibrary you can print 60 more page(s) from a current title.
7. Mylibrary allows **limited downloading options**: "NOTE: The publisher/institution allows you to download a **maximum of 10 pages** per download request." And limited printing options: NOTE: The publisher/institution allows you to print **a maximum of 80 pages** per print request.

MedCalc 3000 encompasses a wide array of pertinent medical formulae, clinical criteria sets and decision tree analysis tools used everyday by clinicians, medical educators, nurses and health care students of all types.)
