International Pharmaceutical Abstracts: pharmacology, pharmacy, health-related literature
Lexicomp: includes AHFS monographs, I.V. Compatibility (King Guide), Drug I.D. (images of tablets and capsules), Toxicology, Interactions and Calculators
Medline: via OvidSP or PubMed
Natural Standard: evidence-based medicine resource on alternative and complementary therapies. Includes drug interactions for herbs and supplements
Scopus: an interdisciplinary resource for searching the drug literature
UpToDate: drug interaction data with Lexicomp's "Lexi-Interact" database
