Physiology Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay, or the best Examination on a subject pertaining to Physiology (open to undergraduates of the second year), to Earl Blan Ross.

Practice Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay on a subject pertaining to the practice of Medicine, to Harrison Gray, with honorable mention of Basil Tabor Owens and Burton A. Weil.

Therapeutics Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Examination in Therapeutics, to Augustin Mujica-Dueno, with honorable mention of Donald Ammon Gross.

Obstetrics Prize. A Gold Medal for General Excellence in Obstetrics, to Robert Stanley Heffner, with honorable mention of Oscar Pfefferle and Douglas Launeese Cannon.

Surgery Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay on the subject pertaining to Surgery, to Edward Woodbridge Beach, with honorable mention of Douglas Launeese Cannon.

Chemistry Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Original Work in Physiological Chemistry (open to undergraduates), to Bruce Leon Fleming, with honorable mention of Henry Lewis Hansell.

Anatomy Prize. A Gold Medal awarded at the completion of the Sophomore Year to the student who has the highest grade in the anatomical subjects of the Freshman and Sophomore Years, to Doff D. Daniel, with honorable mention of Stanley M. Clark and Bruce Leon Fleming.

Pathology Prize. A Gold Medal for General Excellence in the Department of Pathology to Edmund Lloyd Jones.

Gynecology Prize. By Professor Montgomery, a Gold Medal for the best Examination and Clinical Report on Gynecology, to Guy A. Robinhold, with honorable mention of Frederic Clemons Lechner.

Neurology Prize. By Professor Dercum, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Neurology, to Frederic Clemons Lechner, with honorable mention of Edmund Lloyd Jones.

Genito-Urinary Prize. By Professor Loux, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Genito-Urinary Surgery, to Eugene Robbins Simpson, with honorable mention of Thomas Harold Copeland.

Ophthalmology Prize. By Professor Hansell, Twenty-five dollars for the best Examination in Ophthalmology, to Edmund Lloyd Jones, with honorable mention of Clarence Henry Baumgart.

Otology Prize. By Professor S. MacCuen Smith, Twenty-five dollars for the best Examination in Otology, to Frank B. Marsh, with honorable mention of Francis C. Hartung and Emery C. Herman.

Alumni Prize. By the Alumni Association, a Medal for the best general average gained in the examination for the entire curriculum, to Edmund Lloyd Jones.

W. B. Saunders Prize. Seventy-five dollars' worth of their Medical Publications to the student who passes the best General Examination at the end of the Senior Year, to Edmund Lloyd Jones.

The Schaeffer Anatomic League Prize. A Gold Medal given by Professor Schaeffer to the member of the League presenting the best thesis in the science of Anatomy, including Embryology and Histology, and Comparative Anatomy, to Bruce Leon Fleming.

D. Appleton & Co. Prize. Fifty dollars' worth of their Medical Publications to the student who passes the best General Examination at the end of the Junior Year, to Vaughn Clifton Garner.

The Hawk Biochemical Society Prize. A Gold Medal given by Professor Hawk to the member of the Society presenting the best paper upon some designated chemical phase of clinical medicine, to Willard Snow Sargent.
