Neurology Prize. By Professor Alpers, for the best examination in Neurology, to Theodore Joseph Berry.

Psychiatry Prize. By Professor Keyes, for the best examination in Psychiatry, to Warren Reichert Lang, with Honorable Mention of Louis Edmund Zimmer.

Pediatrics Prize. By Professor Bauer, for the best examination in Pediatrics, to Theodore Herman Durr, Jr., with Honorable Mention of John Henry Shackleton, Jr.

Ophthalmology Prize. By Professor Shannon, for the best examination in Ophthalmology, to Warren Reichert Lang, with Honorable Mention of Theodore Herman Durr, Jr., and Theodore Joseph Berry.

Laryngology Prize. By Professor Clerf, for general excellence in Laryngology and Bronchoscopy, to Robert Clare Campbell, with Honorable Mention of Louis George Bush.

Otology Prize. By Professor Williams, for the best examination in Otology, to Warren Reichert Lang, with Honorable Mention of James S. D. Eisenhower, Jr., and Robert Gerard Howe.

The C. V. Mosby Company Prizes, awarded to graduates for excellence in specialties as follows: Surgery, Richard Stuart Jackson; Obstetrics and Gynecology, Joseph Francis McCloskey; Internal Medicine, Robert Jonathon Saul; Urology, Warren Reichert Lang; Pediatrics, Patrick Joseph Costello.

W. B. Saunders Company Prize. Medical publications to the student who passes the best general examination at the end of the Senior Year, to Warren Reichert Lang.

William Potter Memorial Prize. The income from a bequest of Mrs. Adaline Potter Wear, offered to encourage excellence in the clinical branches of medicine and awarded to that graduate attaining the highest general average in the final two years of the medical course, to Warren Reichert Lang.

Alumni Prize. By the Alumni Association, a Medal for the best general average gained in the examinations for the entire curriculum, to Warren Reichert Lang.

UNDERGRADUATE AWARDS*

D. Appleton Century Company Prize. Medical Publications to the student who passes the best general examination at the end of the Junior Year.

Physiology Prize. A Gold Medal, awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best essay, or the best examination, on a subject pertaining to Physiology (open to undergraduates of the Second Year).

Schaeffer Anatomic League Prize. A Gold Medal, awarded by Professor Schaeffer, to the member of the League presenting the best thesis in the science of Anatomy, including Embryology, Histology, and Comparative Anatomy.

Anatomy Prize. A Gold Medal, awarded upon the completion of the Sophomore Year, to the student who has the highest grade in the Anatomical subjects of the Freshman and Sophomore Years.

The Henry Keller Mohler Memorial Prize. Given by Mrs. Jesse Hubschman in memory of Henry Keller Mohler, M.D., to the First-Year Student making the highest standing in the final examination in Physiological Chemistry; the student to be chosen by the Professor of Physiological Chemistry, and the prize to be used for the purchase of textbooks for the Second Year.

*These prizes will be awarded on the completion by the students, of the courses to which these awards apply.
