The Office of Health Policy and Clinical Outcomes recently was awarded two grants to study patient lost productivity. Jennifer H. Lofland, PharmD, will serve as the principal investigator for both grants.

The first grant, awarded through the Aetna US Healthcare Quality Care Research Fund, is entitled "The Aventis Committee on Workplace Productivity Measurement." The second grant, a four-year award entitled "Patient Outcomes: Quality of Life and Lost Productivity" was awarded by the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality.
