My Dear William,

I received a few days ago by post, but not having it by me I cannot answer it particularly, however I will write you again shortly – I recollect one thing that you mentioned money in it, I have none at present[.] the [sic] family are all well at present[.] I shall get off for Philadelphia tomorrow or next day, on some business[.]

You will be pleased to make my respects to the President & Mr[.] M[*Ms*. *illegible*] likewise to Ca[p]t[ai]n Whipple & Family[.]
