The Henry M. Phillips Prize of Seventy-five Dollars. Awarded upon the recommendation of the Profossors of Surgery to the graduate in their opinion most worthy, to Emile Lester Cottrell, of California.

Physiology Prize. Awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Examination on a subject pertaining to Physiology (open to undergraduates of the second year), to George Fergison Doyle, of Pennsylvania.

Therapeutics Prize. A Gold Medal, for the best Examination in Therapeutics, to Harry Hudson, Jr., of Pennsylvania.

Surgery Prize. Awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Examination in Surgery, to Charles W. Fogarty, of Minnesota.

Obstetrical Prize. A Gold Medal, fer General Excellence in Obstetrics, to Ira Bratton Whitehead, of Pennsylvania, with honorable mention of Willard Freeman Sewall, of Maine.

Chemical Prize. A Gold Medal, for the best Examination in Clinical Chemistry (open for undergraduates), to Albert Elmer Austin, of Massachusetts.

Pathology Prize. A Gold Medal, for the best Examination in Pathology, to Thomas Cook Stillwagen, Jr., of Pennsylvania. Gynecology Prize. By Professor Montgomery, a Gold Medal, for the best Examination in Gynecology, to William Edmunds Kerr, of Ohio, with honorable mention of John Joseph Stanton, of Pennsylvania, and Willis Fastnacht Manges, of Pennsylvania.

Neurology Prize. By Prosessor Dercum, a Gold Medal, for the best Examination in Neurology, to Lawrence Wellington Dana, of Pennsylvania, with honorable mention of William Edmunds Kerr, of Ohio.

The W. S. Forbes Anatomical League Prize of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars, given by Professor Forbes to the member of the Anatomical League having the higest standing in a competative Examination in Anatomy, to Michael Joseph O'Neill, of Rhode Island, with honorable mention of Arthur E. Crow, of Pennsylvania.

Clinical Orthopedics Prize. By Professor H. Augustus Wilson, Gold Medal, for the best Examination in Orthopedic Surgery, to Henry Stokes Munroe, of North Carolina, with honorable mention of Robert Batten Mervine, of Pennsylvania.

Clinical Pediatrics Prize. By Professor Graham, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Report on his Clinics, to Norman William Neptune, of Ohio, with honorable mention of William Edmunds Kerr, of Ohio.

Clinical Genito-Urinary Prize. By Professor Horwitz, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Examination in Genito-Urinary Surgery, to Henry Stokes Munroe, of North Carolina, with honorable mention of Arthur F. McCormick, of Pennsylvania.

Clinical Obstetrics Prize. By Professor Davis, Twenty-five Dollars, for excellent work in out-patient service, awarded to Clyde R. Larkens, of Ohio, and Henry Urban North, of Pennsylvania.

Clinical Ophthalmology Prize. By Professor Hansell, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Report of his Clinics, to Robert Batten Mervine, of Pennsylvania, with honorable mention of George Anthony Davis, of Connecticut.

Clinical Otology Prize. By Professor S. MacCuen Smith, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Examination in Otology, to William H. Tomlinson, of Pennsylvania, with honorable mention of Henry Stokes Munroe, of North Carolina, and Edwin Rahn Flemming, of Pennsylvania.

Clinical Dermatology Prize. By Professor Stelwagon, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Examination in Dermatology, to William Edmunds Kerr, of Ohio, with honorable mention of William Emory Hyskell, of Pennsylvania.

Clinical Laryngology Prize. By Professor Kyle, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Original Essay on a subject pertaining to Laryngology and Rhinology, to Frederick Charles Smith, of Minnesota, with honorable mention of Marvin Warren Reed, of Pennsylvania, and William H. Tomlinson, of Pennsylvania.

Clinical Laryngology Prize. By Professor Jones, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Report of his Clinics, to John Walter Flatley, of Pennsylvania.

Alumni Prize. By the Alumni Association, a Medal for the best General Average gained in the examinations for the entire curriculum, to John Joseph Stanton, of Pennsylvania.

W. B. Saunders Prize. Twenty Volumes complete of Saunders' Medical Hand Atlases, to the student who passes the best General Examination at the close of the next college term, to John Joseph Stanton, of Pennsylvania.

Out-patient Obstetric Prize. By Dr. W. H. Wells, Demonstrator of Clinical Obstetrics, a Case of Instruments, for the best Report of work in Out-Patient-Maternity Service, to George William Hixson, of Ohio, with honorable mention of Lorraine L. Schwartz, of Pennsylvania, and Abraham Joseph Cohen, of Pennsylvania.
