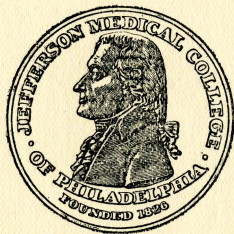

Clinical Obstetrics Prize. By Professor Davis, Twenty-five Dollars for the best report of his clinics to Walter Clemens Raymond, with honorable mention of Alexander Sands Rochester.

Ophthalmology Prize. By Professor Hansell, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Report of his Clinics, to Louis Joseph Spivak.

Otology Prize. By Professor S. MacCuen Smith, Twenty-five Dollars for the best Examination in Otology. Two examination records showing equal merit the prize has been duplicated, one being awarded to William Calvin Roller and the other to Henry Craig Fleming, with honorable mention of Joseph Flanner Patterson and James William Tankersley.

Dermatology Prize. By Professor Stelwagon, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Examination in Dermatology, to William Stair Weakley, with honorable mention of Stewart Mann Uhler, George Julius Feldstein and Walter Clemens Raymond.

Laryngology Prize. By Professor Kyle, a Gold Medal, for the best report of clinical lectures on Laryngology, to Henry Craig Fleming, with honorable mention of James William Tankersley and Walter Clemens Raymond.

Alumni Prize. By the Alumni Association, a Medal, for the best General Average gained in the examinations for the entire curriculum, to Walter Clemens Raymond.
