The following prizes were awarded:

Physiology Prize. Awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay, or the best Examination on a subject pertaining to Physiology (open to undergraduates of the second year) to Edward R. Prigger.

Practice Prize. Awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay on a subject pertaining to the practice of Medicine, to Alfred Andrew Robinson, with honorable mention of Elmer Hendricks Funk.

Therapeutic Prize. A Gold Medal for the best examination in Therapeutics, to Charles Perry Crandall.

Surgery Prize. Awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain for the best Essay on a subject pertaining to Surgery, to Will John Carrington, with honorable mention of Harry Jacob Hartz.

Obstetrical Prize. A Gold Medal for General Excellence in Obstetrics, to Howard Lane Hull, with honorable mention of Marshall C. Rumbaugh.

Chemical Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Original Work in the Chemical Laboratory (open to undergraduates), to Warren B. Davis.

Anatomy Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Anatomical Preparation (open to undergraduates), to Robert Boyd Pratt.

Pathology Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Essay embodying original research on some subject connected with Pathology, to Howard Lane Hull.

Gynecology Prize. By Professor Montgomery, Gold Medal for the best examination in Gynecology, to George Elmer Krout, with honorable mention of John Francis Evens and Carl Edward Holmberg.

Neurology Prize. By Professor Dercum, a Gold Medal, for the best Examination in Neurology, to George Elmer Krout, with honorable mention of Thurman Delna Kitchin and Carl Edward Holmberg.

Orthopedics Prize. By Professor H. Augustus Wilson, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Orthopedic Surgery, to George Elmer Krout, with honorable mention of Otto Mathias Rott and Elmer Hendricks Funk.

Pediatrics Prize. By Professor Graham, Twenty-five Dollars for the best report on his Clinics, to Archie Lee Brown.

Genito-Urinary Prize. By Professor Horwitz, Twenty-five Dollars for the best examination in Genito-Urinary Surgery, to Frederick William Shafer.

Ophthalmology Prize. By Professor Hansell, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best examination in Ophthalmology, to Leo Thomas Perrault.

Otology Prize. By Professor S. MacCuen Smith, Twenty-five Dollars for the best Examination in Otology, to George Elmer Krout, with honorable mention of Horace Merrill and Marshall C. Rumbaugh.

Laryngology Prize. By Professor Kyle, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Original Essay on a subject pertaining to Laryngology and Rhinology, to Augustine Charles Luhr, with honorable mention of Carlyle Kedzie MacMurdy.

Alumni Prize. By the Alumni Association, a medal, for the best general average gained in the Examination for the entire Curriculum, to George Elmer Krout.

W. B. Saunders Prize. Twenty-three Volumes complete of Saunders' Medical Hand Atlases, to the student who passes the best General Examination at the end of the Senior year, to George Elmer Krout.

Out-Patient Obstetric Prize. By Dr. W. H. Wells, Associate in Clinical Obstetrics, a case of Instruments, for the best Report of Work in Out-Patient Maternity Service, to Will John Carrington, with honorable mention of Arthur Elmer Simonis and Jacob Louis Tint.
