Comments: I have been diagnosed with bipolar OCD since about 1995. I am a fully functional person with a wonderful career and family, but mental health issues significantly affect my life and my family's lives. While I have benefited from competent mental health professionals and family physicians, the turnover in my doctors means that I am usually seeing younger doctors who know less about me and my reactions to drugs and who sometimes prescribe meds with "few" side effects that nearly kill me. Abilify is one of these. I have learned that I need to be my own best advocate. Having access to journal articles helps me assess treatment options and understand my reaction to various drugs. I currently take 1,600 MG gabapentin daily for RLS and neuropathy of my lower legs and feet. I also take methadone 10mg and LOrAzepam 2 mg. Thank you for making this article available, I have NEVER heard about gabapentin and bipolar.

Especially the lack of improvement when buproprion is used at the dose of 450mg versus 150mg daily, and yet had there was increased side effects for this population. I knew this, and have seen it, but seeing it in research material gives it much more credibility.
