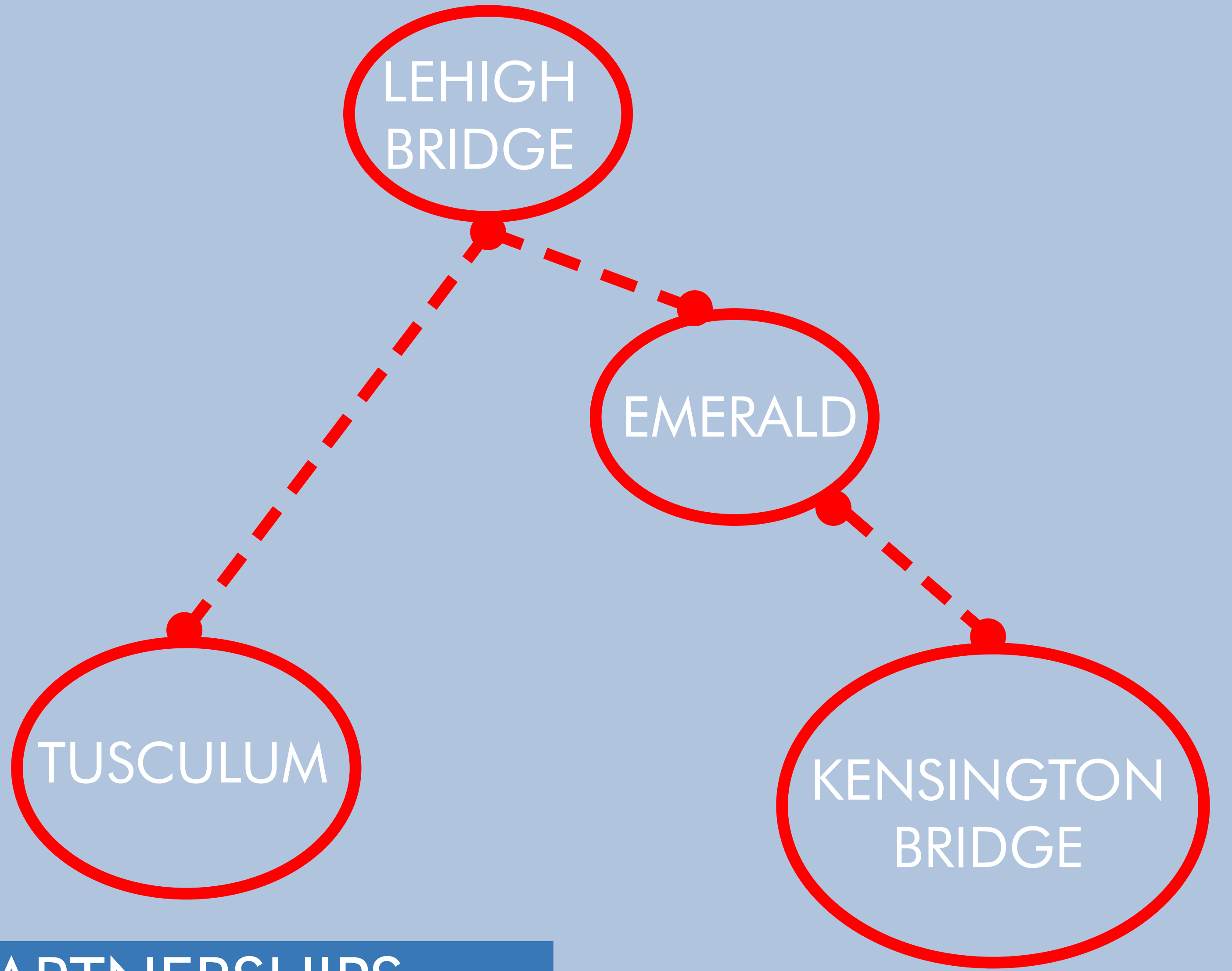
MISSION
