Therapeutics Prize. A Gold Medal for the best examination in Therapeutics, to David Miller Dry.

Obstetrics Prize. A Gold Medal for General Excellence in Obstetrics, to David Miller Dry, with honorable mention of Paul Edgar Schwartz and Jacob Walker.

Surgery Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay on the subject pertaining to Surgery, to Karl Dean Figley.

Chemistry Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Original Work in the Chemical Laboratory (open to undergraduates), to John Lee Hydrick.

Anatomy Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Anatomical Preparation (open to undergraduates), to John Lee Hydrick, with honorable mention of Joseph Aspel.

Pathology Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Examination in the Department of Pathology, to David Miller Dry, with honorable mention of Karl Dean Figley.

Neurology Prize. By Professor Dercum, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Neurology, to Lee Fillmen Mauger, with honorable mention of Fred August Thysell and Cleon W. Colby.

Orthopedics Prize. By Professor H. Augustus Wilson, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Orthopedic Surgery, to Robert Maffet Palmer, with honorable mention of John B. L. Flick and Horace G. Dunham.

Genito-Urinary Prize. By Professor Loux, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Genito-Urinary Surgery, to Horace Garfield Dunham.

Ophthalmology Prize. By Professor Hansell, Twenty-five dollars for the best Examination in Ophthalmology, to Frederick R. Lummis, with honorable mention of Roy E. Wiant.

Otology Prize. By Professor S. MacCuen Smith, Twenty-five dollars for the best Examination in Otology, to Robert Maffet Palmer, with honorable mention of Horace Garfield Dunham and Reeve Leslie Ballinger.

Alumni Prize. By the Alumni Association, a Medal for the best general average gained in the examination for the entire curriculum, to David Miller Dry.

W. B. Saunders Prize. Twenty-three volumes, complete, of Saunders' Medical Hand Atlases, to the student who passes the best General Examination at the end of the Senior year, to David Miller Dry.

Out-Patient Obstetric Prize. By Professor W. H. Wells, a Case of Instruments for the best Report of Work in Out-Patient Maternity Service, to Joseph T. Murphy, with honorable mention of James R. Garber.

The Spitzka Anatomic League Prize. A Gold Medal given by Professor Spitzka to the member of the League presenting the best original contribution to the science of anatomy, including embryology and histology, to Mitchell Porter Stiles, with honorable mention of John Lee Hydrick.
