The following prizes were awarded:

The Henry M. Phillips Prize of Seventy-five dollars. Awarded upon the recommendation of the Professors of Surgery, to the graduate in their opinion most worthy, to Harold Flavell Westcott.

Physiology Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay, or the best Examination on a subject pertaining to Physiology (open to undergraduates of the second year), to James Wilson Gibbon.

Practice Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay on a subject pertaining to the practice of Medicine, to Wade Hampton Sherrill, with honorable mention of Herschel C. Walker.

Therapeutics Prize. A Gold Medal for the best examination in Therapeutics, to William Henry Spencer.

Obstetrics Prize. A Gold Medal for General Excellence in Obstetrics, to Robert Boyd McIver, with honorable mention of George Phillip Meyer.

Surgery Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay on the subject pertaining to Surgery, to Robert Boyd McIver.

Chemistry Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Original Work in the Chemical Laboratory (open to undergraduates), to Henry Kajetan Seelaus, with honorable mention of Albert Warren James and Walter Gray Klugh.

Anatomy Prize. A Gold Medal awarded at the completion of the Sophomore Year to the student who has the highest grade in the anatomical subjects of the Freshman and Sophomore Years, to Henry Kajetan Seelaus, with honorable mention of William C. Dorasavage, Albert Warren James and Walter Gray Klugh.

Pathology Prize. A Gold Medal for general excellence in the Department of Pathology, to George Phillip Meyer.

Gynecology Prize. By Professor Montgomery, a Gold Medal for the best Clinical Report on Gynecology, to Ernest Gotshall Williamson, with honorable mention of James Joseph Monahan and William Theodore Palchanis.

Neurology Prize. By Professor Dercum, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Neurology, to Ralph Stanley Stauffer, with honorable mention of Allan Wilson Dawson and Olin Henry Jennings.

Orthopedics Prize. By Professor H. Augustus Wilson, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Orthopedic Surgery, to Harold Snow Babcock, with honorable mention of Richard Samuel Magee and William Henry Spencer.

Genito-Urinary Prize. By Professor Loux, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Genito-Urinary Surgery, to William Walsh Lermann.

Ophthalmology Prize. By Professor Hansell, Twenty-five dollars for the best Examination in Ophthalmology, to Vincent Gorman Smith, with honorable mention of William Henry Spencer and George Phillip Meyer.

Otology Prize. By Professor S. MacCuen Smith, Twenty-five dollars for the best Examination in Otology, to William Henry Spencer, with honorable mention of William Britton Crawford and Thomas Rogers Morgan.

Laryngology Prize. By Professor Kyle, Twenty-five dollars for the best Original Essay on a subject pertaining to Laryngology and Rhinology to George Kegley Nutting.

Alumni Prize. By the Alumni Association, a Medal for the best general average gained in the examination for the entire curriculum, to William Henry Spencer.

W. B. Saunders Prize. Twenty-three volumes complete, of Saunders' Medical Hand Atlases, to the student who passes the best General Examination at the end of the Senior year, to Robert Boyd McIver.

Out-Patient Obstetric Prize. By Professor W. H. Wells, a Case of Instruments for the best Report of Work in Out-Patient Maternity Service, to Ulrich Peter Horger, with honorable mention of Robert Boyd McIver.

The Schaeffer Anatomic League Prize. A Gold Medal given by Professor Schaeffer to the member of the League presenting the best thesis in the science of Anatomy, including Embryology and Histology, and Comparative Anatomy, to James Wilson Gibbon, with honorable mention of Harry Ernest Heinitsh, Jr., and James Lee Fisher.
