Therapeutics Prize. A Gold Medal for the best Examination in Therapeutics, to Evon Lucian Anderson.

Obstetrics Prize. A Gold Medal for General Excellence in Obstetrics, to Milton Harlan Cloud, with honorable mention of Merle Wayland Moore.

Surgery Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain for the best Essay on the subject pertaining to Surgery, to Aaron Capper.

Gynecology Prize. By Professor Anspach, a Gold Medal for the best Examination and Clinical Report on Gynecology, to Charles Lewis Starr Brennan, with honorable mention of Henry Andrew Brodtkin and Oliver Spurgeon English.

Neurology Prize. By Professor Dercum, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Neurology, to Abraham Cantarow, with honorable mention of Benjamin Herbert Chandlee and Alfred William Friedman.

Genito-Urinary Prize. By Professor Loux, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Genito-Urinary Surgery, to Lester Bowman McDonald, with honorable mention of George Gaillard Rogers.

Ophthalmology Prize. By Professor Hansell, Twenty-five Dollars for the best Examination in Ophthalmology, to Harry Rubin, with honorable mention of Ray Hunter Wharton and Isidor Thomas Strittmatter.

Otology Prize. By Professor S. MacCuen Smith, Twenty-five Dollars for the best Examination in Otology, to John Wilfrid Parent, with honorable mention of Thomas Edward Joseph Larkin.

Pediatrics Prize. By Professor Graham, a Gold Medal for the best Examination in Pediatrics, to Francis Thomas Carney, with honorable mention of Earl Strawn Phillips and Abraham Cantarow.

Alumni Prize. By the Alumni Association, a Medal for the best general average gained in the Examinations for the entire curriculum, to Aaron Capper.

W. B. Saunders' Company Prize. Seventy-five Dollars' worth of their Medical Publications to the student who passes the best General Examination at the end of the Senior Year, to Benjamin Herbert Chandlee.

Physiology Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best Essay, or the best Examination on a subject pertaining to Physiology (open to undergraduates of the Second Year), to Isadore Lewis Sandler, with honorable mention of John Barrick Montgomery and George Cupp Griffith.

Anatomy Prize. A Gold Medal awarded at the completion of the Sophomore Year to the student who has the highest grade in the anatomical subjects of the Freshman and Sophomore Years, to George Cupp Griffith, with honorable mention of John Barrick Montgomery and James Everette Coleman.

The Schaeffer Anatomic League Prize. A Gold Medal given by Professor Schaeffer to the member of the League presenting the best thesis in the science of Anatomy, including Embryology and Histology, and Comparative Anatomy, to Gerald Edward Pratt, with honorable mention of Eugene Manigault Baker, Jr.

D. Appleton & Co. Prize. Fifty Dollars' worth of their Medical Publications to the student who passes the best General Examination at the end of the Junior Year, to Vincent Timothy Curtin.
