Practice Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best essay on a subject pertaining to the Practice of Medicine, to George Albert Silver.

Surgery Prize. A Gold Medal awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best essay on a subject pertaining to Surgery, to Paul Harry Morton, with honorable mention of Paul Edward Chodoff and Alison Howe Price.

Gynecology Prize. By Professor Anspach, Twenty-five Dollars for the best examination and clinical report on Gynecology, to Alison Howe Price, with honorable mention of Charles March Bancroft, George Vernon Judson, Jr., Leo Michael Wachtel, Jr., Jacob Samuel Wiener.

Otology Prize. By Professor Williams, Twenty-five Dollars for the best examination in Otology, to Welland Angel Hause, with honorable mention of Ralph Burroughs Vance.

Clinical Surgery Prize. A Gold Medal for general excellence in Clinical Surgery, in memory of Francis Torrens Stewart, Professor of Clinical Surgery, Jefferson Medical College, 1910-1920, to William Wallace Lumpkin Glenn, with honorable mention of Solomon Jacob Axelrod and Ephriam Manuel Rosset.

Obstetrics Prize. By Professor Vaux, a Gold Medal for the best examination in Obstetrics, to Gerald Krosnick.

Orthopedics Prize. By Professor Rugh, Twenty-five Dollars to the member of the Senior Class presenting the best report of the clinics in Orthopedic Surgery, to Edward Stephens Phillips, with honorable mention of Jacob Samuel Wiener.

Pediatrics Prize. By Professor Bauer, Twenty-five Dollars for the best examination in Pediatrics, to Ralph Burroughs Vance, with honorable mention of William Wallace Lumpkin Glenn.

Ophthalmology Prize. By Professor Shannon, Twenty-five Dollars for the best examination in Ophthalmology, to Morris Jack Shapiro, with honorable mention of Paul Harry Morton.

**Laryngology Prize.** By Professor Clerf, Twenty-five Dollars for general excellence in Laryngology and Bronchoscopy, to Solomon Jacob Axelrod.

**Neurology Prize.** By the late Professor Burns, a Gold Medal for the best examination in Neurology and Psychiatry, to Solomon Jacob Axelrod, with honorable mention of Charles March Bancroft.

**Therapeutics Prize.** A Gold Medal for the best examination in Therapeutics, to Welland Angel Hause, with honorable mention of Gordon Elias Snyder.

**W. B. Saunders Company Prize.** Seventy-five Dollars' worth of their medical publications to the student who passes the best general examination at the end of the Senior Year, to William Wallace Lumpkin Glenn.

**William Potter Memorial Prize.** The income from a bequest of Mrs. Adaline Potter Wear, not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty Dollars, offered to encourage excellence in the clinical branches of medicine, and awarded to that graduate attaining the highest general average in the final two years of the medical course, to William Wallace Lumpkin Glenn.

**Alumni Prize.** By the Alumni Association, a Medal for the best general average gained in the examinations for the entire curriculum, to Morris Jack Shapiro.

**Physiology Prize.** A Gold Medal, awarded by bequest of Dr. Francis W. Shain, for the best essay, or the best examination, on a subject pertaining to Physiology (open to undergraduates of the Second Year), to James Robert Herron, Jr.

**Anatomy Prize.** A Gold Medal awarded upon the completion of the Sophomore Year, to the student who has the highest grade in the Anatomical subjects of the Freshman and Sophomore Years, to Harvey Kenneth Mechanik, with honorable mention of Harry Fremont Kornfield and Harry Henry Clements.

**D. Appleton-Century Company Prize.** Fifty Dollars' worth of their medical publications to the student who passes the best general examination at the end of the Junior Year, to Louis Harry Schinfeld.

**Schaeffer Anatomic League Prize.** A Gold Medal given by Professor Schaeffer, to the member of the League presenting the best thesis in the science of Anatomy, including Embryology, Histology, and Comparative Anatomy, to Richard Lawrence Wagner, with honorable mention of Wayne Pierre Hanson and Francis Kaneshiro.
