Surgery Donald C. Dafoe, MD, FACS Samuel D. Gross Professor of Surgery

Dr. Dafoe joined Jefferson in August 2000 from Stanford University Medical Center in California, where he was Associate Professor and Chief of the Division of Transplantation. An expert in kidney and pancreatic transplantation, Dr. Dafoe built Stanford's program in abdominal organ transplants from zero to more than 225 per year and has a similar growth in activity under way at Jefferson, with the help of key transplantation surgeons recruited here. Having published more than 170 scientific articles, Dr. Dafoe is recognized primarily for his

research in the development of insulin-producing pancreatic islets for the treatment of diabetes through transplantation. He received the American Diabetes Association's Rosalyn S.
