These things I do promise. As I am faithful to this my oath may happiness and good repute be ever mine. The opposite if I shall be forsworn.



With more than two centuries of health care service between them, The Bryn Mawr Hospital and The Lankenau Hospital are full service medical centers providing primary through tertiary care in suburban settings. Services offered by the two Hospitals include cardiology, women's health, family practice, arthritis and orthopaedics, sleep disorders, and psychiatry.
