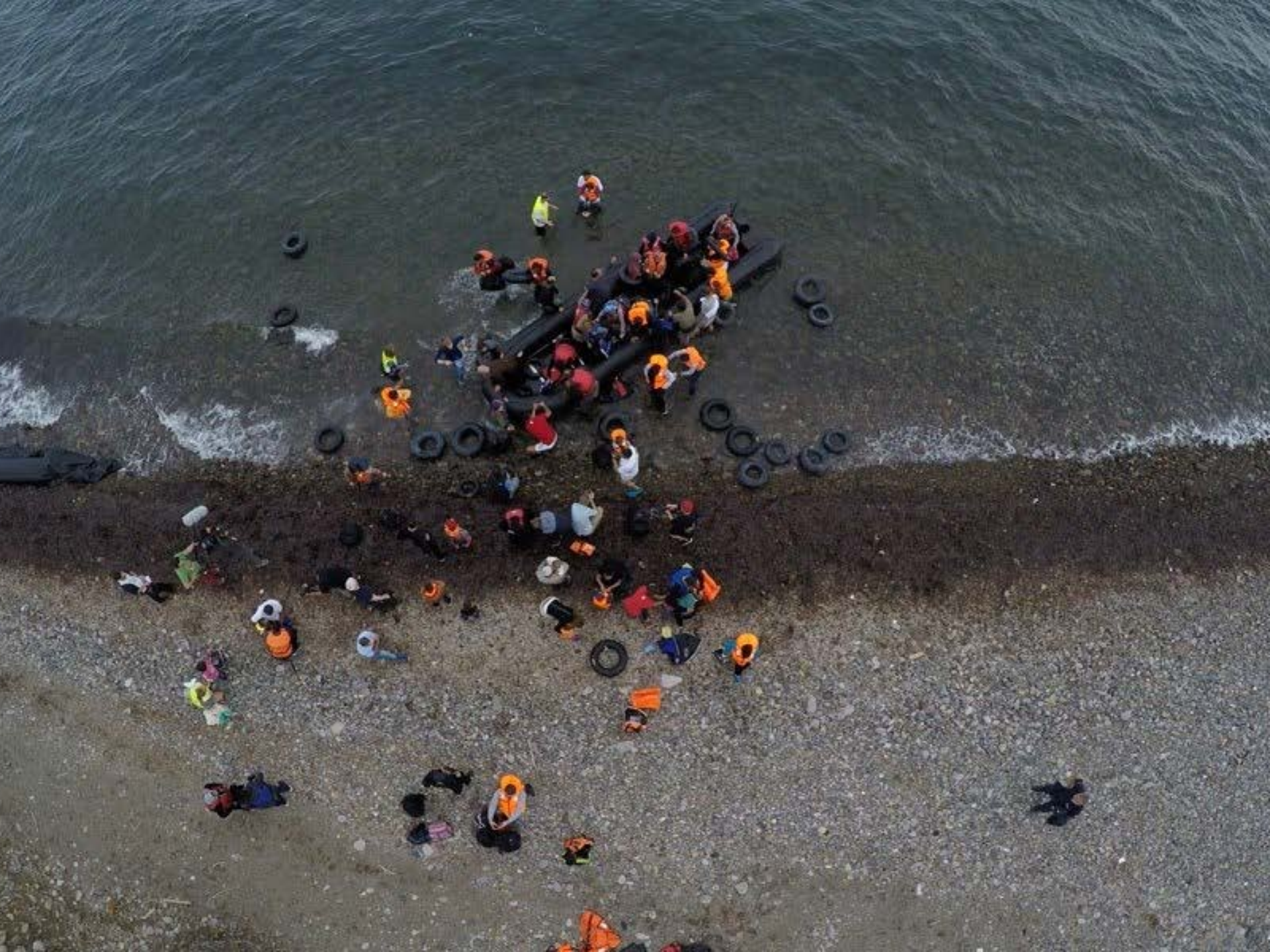

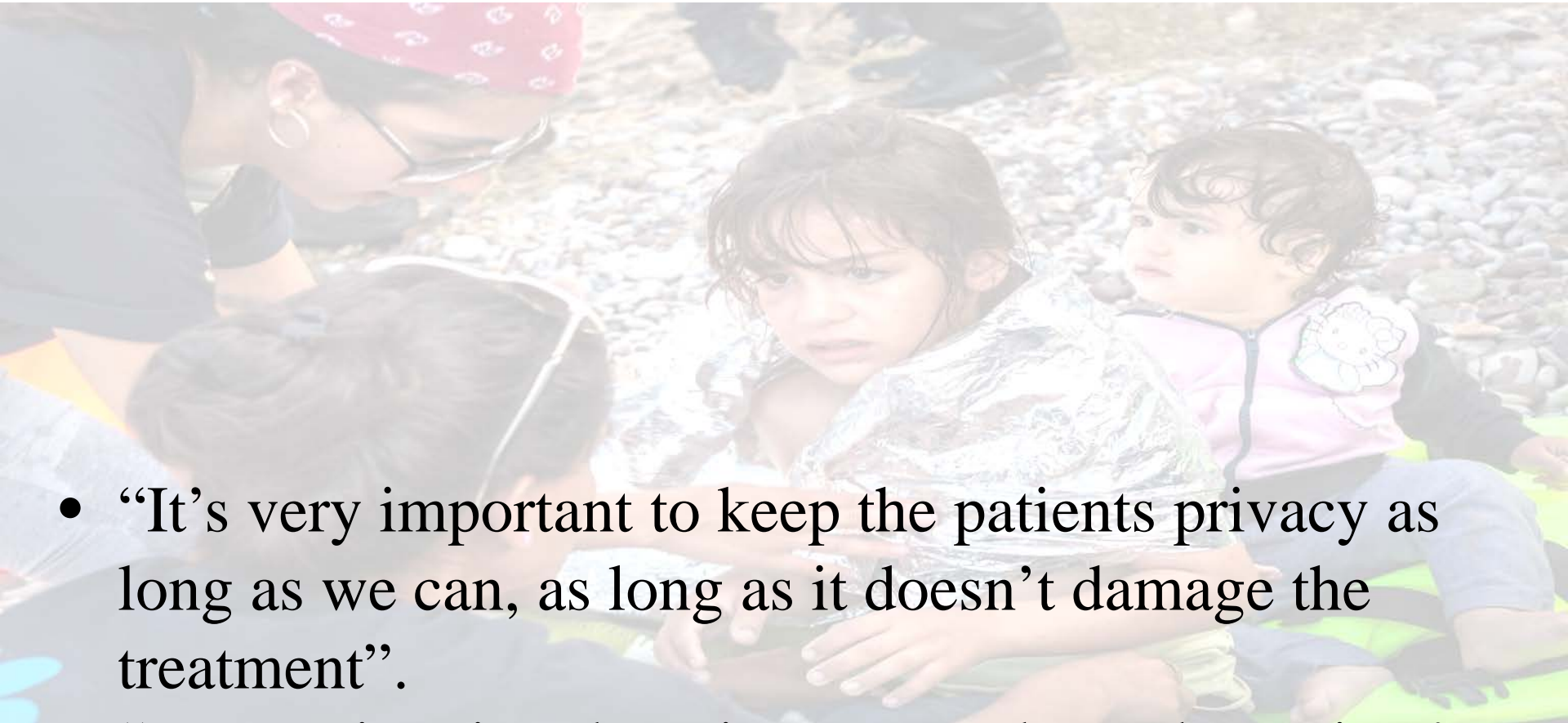

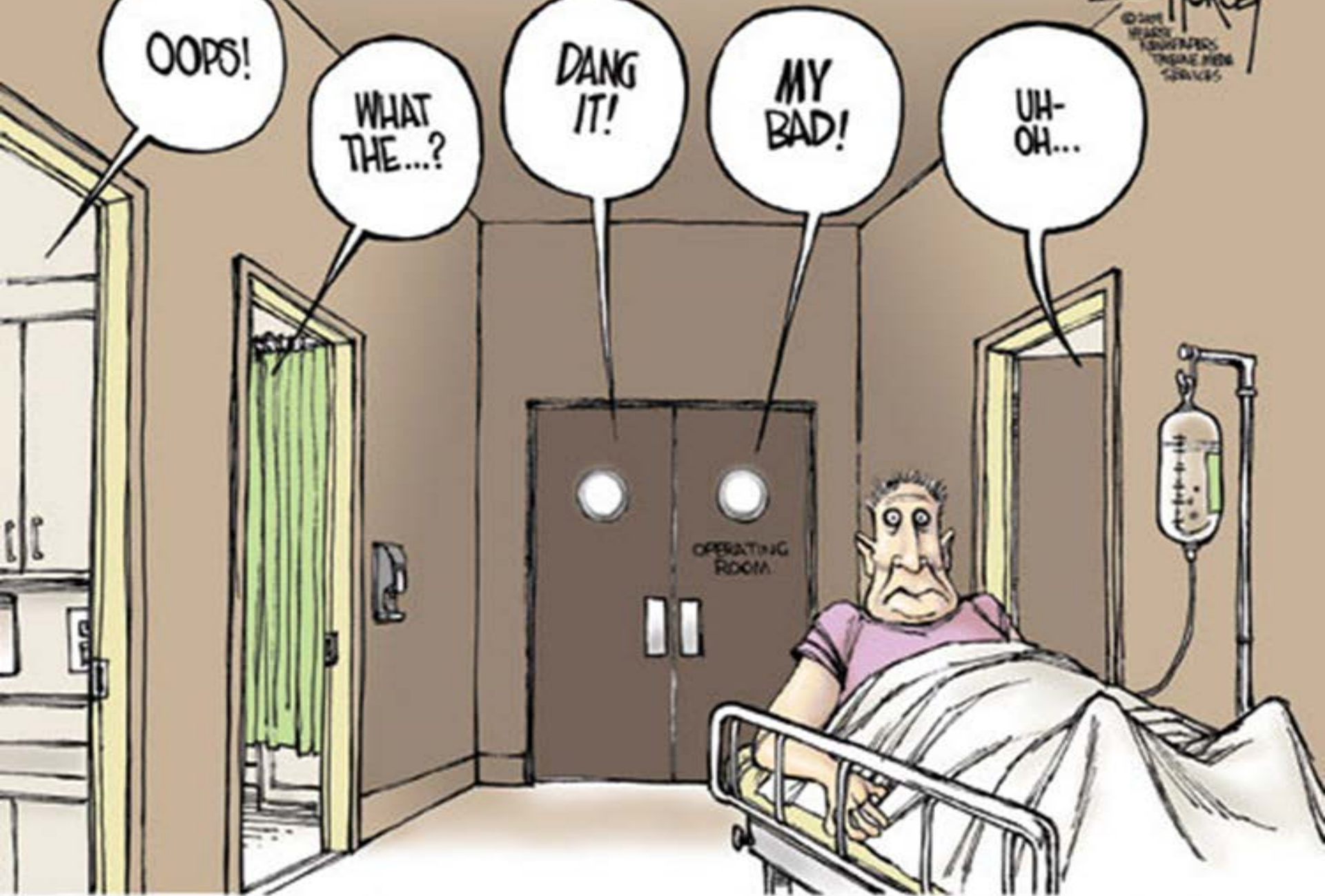


- **"If you manage to keep the patients privacy in the field, we might succeed to do it in the hospital corridor".**
