Doctor of Science – Paul H. O’Neill

Along with his service as the 72nd Secretary of the United States Treasury, Paul H. O’Neill is widely recognized as an accomplished businessman and advocate for public and community service.

Following his graduation from Fresno State College in California where he earned a bachelor’s degree in Economics, Mr. O’Neill earned a master’s degree in Public Administration from Indiana University. He began his public service as a computer systems analyst with the United States Veterans Administration. He joined the United States Office of Management and Budget (OMB) in 1967 and later served as its deputy director. It was here that he gained a mastery of federal budget details and processes. It was also during his government service that Mr. O’Neill helped to shape many of the policies that define the current American healthcare system.

Mr. O’Neill served as vice president then president of the International Paper Company in New York City. From 1987 to 2000, he was Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Alcoa. During his tenure at Alcoa, the company’s revenues increased from \$1.5 billion when he started in 1987 to \$23 billion when he retired as chairman in 2000.

As head of a major corporation with 140,000 employees spread across 36 nations, Mr. O’Neill gained valuable insights into international finance and the global economy. His unique experience transforming an old economy firm into a financial success was chronicled in a study by the Harvard Business School and incorporated into the curriculum of business schools across the nation.

In December 1997, Mr. O’Neill and Karen Wolk Feinstein, President of the Jewish Healthcare Foundation, founded the Pittsburgh Regional Healthcare Initiative (PRHI) to address the problems of regional healthcare. A PRHI-led collaboration in infection control brought about a 63 percent decline in one type of bloodstream infection across the region – with some hospital units virtually eliminating the infection. Regional collaboration also led to the establishment of one of the nation’s largest and most robust registry of data concerning coronary artery bypass graft surgery. Cardiac teams can now glean significant data from over 10,000 cases, yielding nationally important information every day.

The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO), the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), and the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) have supported PRHI’s work, and in many cases, have woven it into their quality improvement platforms.

In 2005 Mr. O’Neill became non-executive Chairman of Value Capture, LLC, and the Value Capture Policy Institute, where he provides counsel and support to healthcare executives and policymakers who share his conviction that the value of healthcare operations can be increased by 50 percent or more through the pursuit of perfect safety and clinical outcomes. Value Capture believes American healthcare needs examples of entire healthcare institutions that are demonstrating this level of excellence across their operations – not in limited project focus areas – to learn from.

He serves as a board member to more than a dozen major corporations and non-profit organizations.

Mr. O’Neill currently resides in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, with his wife Nancy. They have four children and 12 grandchildren.

The University Mace

Originally a medieval weapon, the mace evolved from a short staff weighted with metal (used for breaking armor) into a bejeweled and sculptural relic. It fell into disuse by the 16th century as firearms made protective armor and some hand-to-hand combat weapons obsolete. In one of the earliest ceremonial uses of the mace, it was carried by the royal bodyguard before the French king in the 1200s. Examples of the mace as a symbol of authority in modern government include its use in the British House of Commons where the ceremonial mace has a presence on the Treasury table, and in the U.S. House of Representatives, where it is placed on a pedestal to the right of the Speaker's podium when the House is convened. Universities also used the ceremonial mace, borne by the chief marshal, during academic processions.

The Thomas Jefferson University Mace, carried for the first time in the 1986 commencement ceremonies by Grand Marshal Robert Mandle, PhD, was designed and cast by Howard Serlick, member of the Guild of Master-craftsmen, Winterthur Scholar and Chief Conservator (Gilding) of the Historical Society of Pennsylvania. It was crafted by silversmith Eugene Zweigle and woodturner Michael Copeland.

The four-foot-long, 14-pound mace is made of ebony highlighted with lapis lazuli to reflect Jefferson's colors (black and blue). It features a miniature of Henry Mitchell's sculpture, the "Winged Ox of Saint Luke," symbol of Saint Luke the Physician, the original of which stands on campus beside the Scott Building on Walnut Street. The miniature was cast in silver by Zweigle.

Mitchell's original statue of the "Winged Ox," adopted by the University in 1976 as its symbol of clinical excellence, is mounted on a column containing the names of 50 medical scientists who have most advanced the art of healing. It also reflects the historical evolution of Thomas Jefferson University from its beginnings as Jefferson Medical College in 1824 to its current status as an academic institution comprising the Jefferson Medical College, the Jefferson College of Graduate Studies and the Jefferson College of Health Professions.

The mace, a grand emblem of the University's heritage, is carried at the head of all formal academic processions.

Presidential Medallion of Thomas Jefferson University

The President's Medallion was created for the inauguration of Lewis W. Bluemle Jr., MD, the second President of Thomas Jefferson University, on September 7, 1977. It consists of the four previous official corporate seals of Thomas Jefferson University and the predecessor corporation, the Jefferson Medical College of Philadelphia. These seals were used to mark diplomas, certificates, and other official documents and have been gold-plated to form the Presidential Medallion.

The four seals of the medallion represent the various seals from 1839-2003.

1839-1967 – Represents the first seal. Prior to 1839, diplomas of Jefferson Medical College carried the seal of its parent institution, Jefferson College of Canonsburg, Pennsylvania. When the medical college received its own independent charter in 1838, it established its own seal which depicted the traditional likeness of a young Thomas Jefferson. Below this profile was the date of the College's first graduating class in 1826.

1839-1967 – The second seal is identical to that described above but bears the Latin script *Sigillum Jeffersonianum Medicinae Collegii - Philadelphiae*.

1967-1969 – Represents the creation of the third seal which displayed an updated likeness of Thomas Jefferson and the founding date of 1824, the year that the medical school was first established.

1969-2003 – The fourth seal was created to reflect the major change in the status of the institution as the inscription "Jefferson Medical College" was changed to "Thomas Jefferson University" to also includes the Jefferson College of Graduate Studies and the Jefferson College of Health Professions.

The current version of the seal may be seen on the cover of this program. This modern silhouette looks forward to the University's expanding role in medical education, health care and research in the new millennium.

The Presidential Medallion is worn by the President at all convocations of the University.

The Jefferson Processional

The Jefferson Processional was commissioned by the Alumni Association of Jefferson Medical College and played for the first time on November 15, 1974, at the Sesquicentennial Celebration of the Jefferson Medical College of Thomas Jefferson University. This piece was presented to Thomas Jefferson University by the President of the Alumni Association of the Jefferson Medical College, John J. Garland, M.D. It was composed by Burle Marx.

Academic Regalia

The attire worn at academic ceremonies evolved from the dress worn by clergy in the 12th and 13th centuries. In 1222, the Archbishop of Canterbury, Stephen Langton, decreed that a closed, flowing gown known as the cappa clausa be worn by all clerics within his jurisdiction. Because Oxford and Cambridge were within the provinces of Canterbury, the clerks at both institutions adopted this style of attire. Hoods seem to have served to cover the tonsured head until superseded for that purpose by the skull cap.

Throughout the years European universities have continued to show great diversity in their academic dress. American universities, on the other hand, when they decided to adopt academic dress in 1895, immediately established a code of regulations which today is followed by practically all American institutions. The establishment of this code has made it possible to distinguish the associate's, bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees and, at the same time, recognize the university which has conferred the degree.

The associate in arts and bachelor's gowns have pointed sleeves and are worn closed. The master's gown has oblong sleeves, open at the wrist. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut and the front part has an arc cut away, and is worn open or closed. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves. It is worn open or closed. The majority of gowns are black, but a number of institutions have adopted other colors to identify special programs or groups within that institution.

The hoods vary in length: 48 inches for the doctoral degree, 42 inches for the master's and 36 inches for the bachelor's and associate's. All hoods are lined in silk in the academic color or colors of the institution conferring the degree. If the institution has more than one color, the colors are shown in divisions using chevrons. The binding or edge of the doctoral, master's and bachelor's hoods are usually made of velvet in the color designating the subject in which the degree was granted. The associate's hood does not have a velvet border. The outside is black.

Black mortarboards are most commonly worn; four-sided and six-sided tams of various colors are also used.

Some of the colors in the bindings of the hoods are:
