





Ellis Mount, Editor Emeritus





Oronce Finé was a French astronomer and mathematician who wrote several beautiful treatises on astronomy, including *De Mundi sphaera* (*On the Heavenly Spheres*, Paris, 1542), from which the cover illustration is taken. He was unusual in that he designed most of his woodcut illustrations himself, and he invented a type of shading, known as criblé, that is quite distinctive. The woodcut displays, at the top, an armillary sphere, on which is superimposed a cosmological diagram, with the earth at the center. It stands out nicely against the criblé background. Below, Urania, the muse of astronomy, points to the heavens, while the author (Orontius) demonstrates the use of an astrolabe.
