

Rocket is one of the most famous locomotives of all time. Designed and built by the engineers George Stephenson and his son, Robert, Rocket competed in the famous Rainhill Trials near Liverpool, England in 1829. At the time, the future of steam locomotives was anything but certain, and the Directors of the Liverpool and Manchester Railway had been advised to use fixed steam engines on their new line instead of locomotives. Rocket stunned the onlookers by reaching a dizzying speed of 30 mph in demonstrations, and, by winning the competition, secured the future of locomotives for use on railroads.
