



#### **On the Cover**



Johann Jacob Scheuchzer, a prominent Swiss naturalist, believed that all fossils were relics of Noah's Flood. He was thus delighted to discover, in 1725, the remains of what appeared to be a human who had perished in the Flood. Scheuchzer published a small pamphlet, Homo diluvii testis, the Human Witness of the Flood (Zurich, 1726), in which he illustrated his fossil with a large woodcut. Seventy-five years later, Georges Cuvier would reveal that the fossil was in fact the remains of a large extinct salamander.
