4. A Gold Medal, for the best Examination in Therapeutics, to Harlan Myron Page, (A.B.), of Ohio, with Award of Distinguished Merit to William Gibson Craig, of Iowa.
5. A Gold Medal, for the best Essay on a subject pertaining to the Practice of Medicine, to Thomas Wright Jackson, of Ohio, with honorable mention of the Essay of David Falls Swisher, of Pennsylvania.
