

## How to export Cochrane records into RefWorks

1. Single citation: click on **Export Citation for this Article** in Cochrane Library.

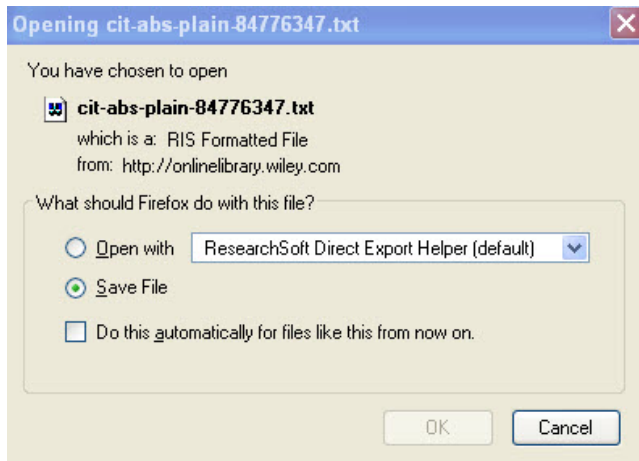

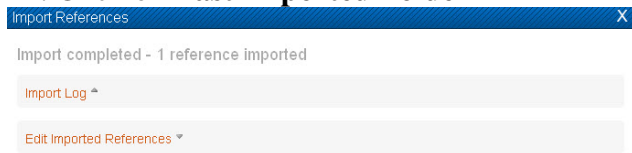
